### **KAPA Awards**

In an effort to have an established “KAPA awards” program. We are presenting three different awards that are listed below. The KAPA President will ask for someone to take on the role of KAPA Awards Coordinator. The “Regional Service of the Year” will need to be voted on and decided in the individual regions. It will be the responsibility of the regional board members to accept the regional nominations for their region and report the results to the KAPA awards coordinator. The “KAPA Director of the Year” and the “Above and Beyond” awards nominations will need to be sent directly to the awards coordinator.

### **KAPA Region Service of the Year**

Each service that is a current member of KAPA may have one nomination for “service of the year” for their region as set in the KAPA By-Laws.

We would ask that you do not nominate your own service.

In the event of a tie between services you will cast a ballot with only those two services listed and let the members of that region vote to break the tie.

KAPA is wanting to award the service in your region that has improved or portrayed excellent representation of what an ambulance service should be in the commonwealth.

Not necessarily the biggest service, or who has the most equipment, but rather who focuses on the quality of service to their community.

You may vote on this at your regional meeting or may have your services communicate their nomination by a set time. It is up to your region.

The awards will be presented to the service at the annual KAPA Conference. Please make sure the service that is awarded this honor is present at the KAPA Conference to receive their award.

### **Director of the Year**

Each service that is a current member of KAPA may nominate one director for “Director of the Year”.

This Director must be with a service that is currently a member of the KAPA organization and is in their group of regions (east or west).

KAPA will award two directors this award. The Western KY Director of the Year (regions 1, 2, 3) and the Eastern KY Director of the Year (regions 4, 5, 6)

Please make sure your nomination contains the director’s name and the service they represent, including the KAPA region they are under.

We want to award a director that stands out above the rest. That works hard for his/her community to have a quality service for their citizens.

The awards will be presented to the service at the annual KAPA Conference.

### **Above and Beyond Award**

Any KAPA Member including employees of services that are KAPA members may nominate someone for the “Above and Beyond Award”.

Anyone within the state of Kentucky that works under the authority of KBEMS is eligible for nomination for this award.

Due to the fact that EMS works in crews it will be allowable for the nomination of a crew.

Please send your nomination to the current KAPA Awards Coordinator. Include the nominees name, title, service they represent, and a summary of what they did to deserve this award.

After the deadline has been reached. The nominations will be reviewed by the KAPA president and or the KAPA Awards Coordinator.

The award will be presented to the individual at the annual KAPA Conference

### **Medical Director of the year ( Eastern and Western)**

Each Service that is a current member of KAPA may nominate one director for “Medical of the Year”.

This Director must be with a service that is currently a member of the KAPA organization and is in their group of regions (east or west).

KAPA will award two medical directors this award. The Western KY Medical Director of the Year (regions 1,2,3) and the Eastern (regions 4,5,6).

Please make sure your nomination contains the medical director’s name and the service they represent, including the KAPA region they are under.

We want to award a medical director that stands out above the rest. That works hard for his/her community to have a quality service for their citizens.

The awards will be presented to the Medical Director’s at the annual KAPA Conference.
